

**South Central Workforce Investment Board (SCWIB) Approved Training Programs
Program Year 2011**

All training must be on the Missouri Hotlink approved WIA training list. The occupation must be in demand in the South Central Region or an area the individual is willing to relocate to and must score a B or better in the Occupational Outlook rating. Training program must also have a graduation rate above 75%, have an in-field of training placement rate above 50% and have a starting wage at or above the current South Central Region negotiated average earnings rate. All training is based on individual need and assessment. The Toolbox Individual Employment Plan goal and the assessment must reflect the need for Occupational Skills Training. WIA funding is not an entitlement program. There is no guarantee of services. All programs are based on regional funding amounts each program year.
